



Intensive EFL Credit Program

The *'Intensive EFL Credit Program'* of the *Lasallian Language Center of De La Salle Araneta University* is an intensive multi-level program, which immerses students in an interactive, lively and motivating environment. Through a systematic, modular approach, the students are exposed to all aspects of language learning. Particular attention is paid to grammar, vocabulary development, pronunciation, and the skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking. The courses are designed to provide the students with maximum exposure to the English language through authentic, interesting and current subject matters.

Program Duration

This is a fundamental 4-week program. Examinations are held on the 4th week. However, the examination schedule is flexible.

General Assessment

Students are assessed based on assignments and examinations for every subject. The final grade for the subject is based on the following criteria:

- In general, the assessment for most subjects is a combination of assignments and exams.
- Assessment for each subject comprises of coursework and examination fundamentally, but this may vary according to each subject.

Coursework (60%)	Attendance 20%, Weekly Tests 20% Assignment 20%
Examination (40%)	Final Exam 40%

- Assignments : various tasks to be completed after class
- Results of examinations are cumulative and official grades are posted after the assessment period.

Policies

- **English Only Policy (EOP):** Students are required to speak English at the Language Center. Violations will incur detentions (forced study period from 19:00 to 20:00)
